Rodney Jones is one of the most recorded guitarists in history. He is at the leading edge of jazz guitar evolution with recordings for Blue Note, Verve, Muse, Highnote, and NTM Records. He was the musical director for the legendary Lena Horne, as well as R&B Legend, Ruth Brown. With performances as diverse as The Manhattan Transfer and James Brown, Jimmy Smith and Carly Simon, Jones combines these influences into a seamless tapestry of sounds that is warm and exciting.

He is currently working with the Rodney Jones Trio as well as the brilliant bassist Christian McBride. He was featured on McBride's most recent grammy winning recording, "Bringin' It" in a moving tribute to Wes Montgomery. He has been a professor at the Juilliard School and The Manhattan School of Music for many years and travels the

world giving clinics and workshops.

Carl Allen is one of the most celebrated drummers in jazz history. He has worked with a virtual who's who of jazz royalty including Freddie Hubbard and Benny Golson. He was the Artistic Director of Jazz Studies at the Juilliard School for years and continues to perform and teach around the world.

Lonnie Plaxico is the first call bassist on the contemporary New York jazz scene. he has worked with Wynton Marsalis, Art Blakey, and has been the musical director for jazz vocalist, Cassandra Wilson.
